- The Festival Executive has given careful consideration to the classes in this syllabus. NO ADDITIONS OR CHANGES will be made for this year's Festival. Additional classes and suggestions will be accepted by any Executive member for consideration in next year's Festival.
- Performers, accompanists and adjudicators shall not use photocopied copyright music under any circumstances unless written permission is obtained from the publisher. Proof of payment for a downloaded copy of such music will be accepted as the required written permission. Presentation of unauthorized photocopied music will result in disqualification from the class.
- Performers require two originals of own choice music selections; one for the adjudicator and one for the accompanist (if any). Performers should also have original music for themselves if they are not performing from memory (e.g. instrumental performances with accompaniment). Music is to be passed in to the registration desk **at least 15 minutes before** the class.
- Individual/solo entries, duet/trio/quartet entries, and group (band, choir, ensembles) entries must be on their appropriate registration forms. Please note there are three types of form.
- Participants are responsible for their own stage arrangements, e.g. props, music stands, unusual lighting, etc., and are also responsible for returning the stage to its original state for subsequent performers. Band entries will receive assistance in set-up and take-down.
- Conflicts in scheduling sometimes occur. Where a competitor is entered in time-conflicting classes, the teacher or competitor must elect to withdraw from sufficient classes to avoid the conflicts.
- If you perform as well as play for other performers, please tell us on your entry form the names of the other performers whom you will be accompanying. If possible we will try to accommodate you in the schedule.
- Each school classroom must register on a separate entry form, e.g. Mrs. Smith's Grade 3 class. This is to assist in program scheduling.
- If a duet, trio or ensemble consists of participants of various ages and/or levels, they must compete at the highest age, grade or level represented.

## GENERAL RULES

1. The Truro Music Festival is open to all those interested in music.
2. Where there is an age requirement, age will be reckoned as of the first day of January.
3. Entry fees must accompany entry forms or applications will be refused. No refunds once class has been entered.
4. Entry Fees:

(a) School choruses, choirs, classroom singing groups, school bands (unless otherwise indicated), family groups	\$ 10.00
(b) Solos	\$ 10.00
(c) Duets	\$ 15.00
(d) Groups of Three to Ten (Ensembles)	\$ 15.00
(e) Community Choruses, Choirs, Bands	\$ 20.00
(f) Open and Adult classes:	
Solos	\$ 10.00
Duets	\$ 15.00
Groups of Three to Ten	\$ 20.00
5. Individuals are responsible for obtaining their own music.
6. The Festival will provide adjudicators with copies of test pieces.
7. Non-competitive participants will be given adjudication only, no marks. Participants in non-competitive classes are not eligible to enter competitive classes in the same category. For example, non-competitive voice does not enter competitive voice. Exceptions will be allowed for Student/Teacher and Family duets or groupings ONLY.
8. Following are the school grade/age/RCM grade classifications unless otherwise noted:

### **Piano & Voice:**

Where not indicated by RCM classifications, the following age groupings are implied:

Novice	Age 8 and under
Junior	Age 12 and under
Intermediate	Age 15 and under
Senior	Age 16 and over
Open	University level
Adult	Non-School/University

## **Schools, Choirs, Bands** (unless otherwise specified):

Novice	Grade 4 and under
Junior	Grade 7 and under
Intermediate	Grade 9 and under
Senior	Grade 12 and under
Open	University level
Adult	Non-School/University

## **NOTE:**

Please note that most school band classes will use the Canadian Band Association National Voluntary Curriculum and Standards for Instrumental Music (Band), whereby the selections chosen will determine the level of entry. For School Choirs and other School Band classes, no more than 10% of the participants in the group may exceed the specified level by 2 grades/age.

9. An ENSEMBLE is defined as a group of from 3 to 10.
10. A CHOIR is defined as a selected group from one or from several classes.
11. A CHORUS is defined as all children from several classes.
12. CLASSROOM SINGING is defined as all children from one class. If a Choir or a Chorus contains children from different grades, then the Choir or Chorus must compete at the level of the highest grade represented in the group.
13. Participants must perform the specified edition of the test piece in the syllabus.
14. All selections are to be performed in the key stated in the test piece with the following exceptions:
  - (a) Choruses, Choirs & Classroom Singing Groups may raise or lower the key one full tone.
  - (b) School Instrumental Groups may raise or lower the key one full tone.
  - (c) Choruses, Choirs & Classroom Singing Groups may transpose "Own Choice" music to a suitable key.
15. All School Choruses, Choirs & Classroom Singing Groups may be accompanied by no more than two instruments, with the exception of Jazz/Blues, Choirs and Choruses.
16. Amplification is permitted only in Stage Band Classes and in Jazz/Blues and Pop Classes (including Jazz Choirs). Otherwise, NO AMPLIFICATION IS PERMITTED.
17. THE ADJUDICATOR'S DECISION SHALL BE FINAL. Any criticism must be made in writing to the Festival within 24 hours following the adjudication.
19. All classes will be judged on tone, technique, dynamics, phrasing and interpretation. Choral and Vocal classes will be judged on diction as well.
20. Performers are expected to present themselves with customary stage deportment. This will be a factor in the adjudicator's assessment of the performers.
21. In test pieces, solo participants must perform their age group selection. If desired, participants may also play or sing one class up from their age groups.

22. Solo and duet participants in voice and piano classes, excepting oratorio, are expected to memorize their music. Adjudicators will deduct two points for the use of music. In the event of a tie for first place, the participant performing from memory will be preferred. If not performing from memory, original music is required.
23. Conductors are not permitted to participate with their groups during a performance. Participants will be disqualified, or marks deducted if the conductor participates with her/his group during adjudication.
24. Sight singing/reading classes will be held in private; NO AUDIENCE WHATSOEVER.
25. Unless otherwise indicated in the Syllabus, "Own Choice" refers to a single selection.
26. Each participant (or conductor/teacher) is responsible for passing in "Own Choice" music together with the information required on the "Own Choice" Form, to the music desk at least 15 minutes prior to his/her class. Failure to provide this music on time will result in disqualification.
27. Canada has a very stringent copyright law. Please do not mimeograph, photocopy, Xerox or otherwise copy any part or portion of music without authorization from the copyright owner. The Adjudicators will refuse to adjudicate a contestant who provides a reproduction of a piece of copyrighted music. Downloaded music will be accepted only if accompanied by a proof of payment or other written authorization.
28. All participants must be present at the correct location 15 minutes before their class time. If this is not possible, then the Venue Co-ordinator must be informed.
29. Participants are to remain in their seats during each performance, and ABSOLUTE QUIET is mandatory.
30. No photography or electronic recording in any form is permitted during a performance.
31. Participants, teachers and parents of participants must refrain from socializing with adjudicators until after the Festival is over.
32. Awards are made in consultation with the adjudicators.
33. The Truro Music Festival Society may withhold an award or trophy in the case of a mark below 85.
34. All award cheques must be cashed within one month of receipt.
35. Because of increased numbers of classes in recent years, it is not possible for all first place winners to perform in the Festival Concerts. Award winners and participants who have been recommended by an adjudicator to perform will be notified as soon as possible.
36. Recommendations made for the Provincial Music Festival are made by the adjudicator(s) involved, using the provincial guidelines with all session performances being considered.
37. Participants who are not going to perform in their chosen class are to provide the Festival with at least twenty-four (24) hour notification if at all possible.
38. Once the program is printed and distributed, no changes in scheduling of classes will be considered and/or implemented.

39. **University students** are required to enter **Open classes** and/or **Senior Concert groups**, regardless of age.
40. All instrumental and vocal soloists are advised that they may be accompanied by one instrument (usually piano). Each soloist is responsible for getting his/her accompanist.
41. To assist the adjudicators, entrants in Senior Voice, Senior Piano and Senior Musical Theatre classes may be requested to notify the Festival of the title, composer, publisher/edition and estimated duration of any 'Own Choice' selection(s) to be performed during the Festival.

**Senior Musical Theatre..... not required for 2012**

Includes musical theatre, jazz/blues and pop vocal solo, duet, ensemble and group classes designated "Age 14 and under" and up, Adult or Open.

**Senior Voice.....not required for 2012**

Includes vocal solo, duet, trio and ensemble classes designated "Age 14 and under" and up, Intermediate level or higher, Adult or Open.

**Senior Piano.....not required for 2012**

Includes piano solo, duet and group classes (all styles) designated RCM Grade 5 or higher, Intermediate level or higher, 13 years of age and up, Adult or Open.

### Provincial Festival Recommendations

Recommendations for the Provincial Music Festival are strictly the prerogative of the Adjudicators and may be made in the following categories. Local festival entrants who are interested in competing in the Provincial Music Festival should consult the Provincial and National Regulations section of this Syllabus.

*Brass Solo, Junior and Senior*

### Festival Awards Criteria

#### Musical Theatre Awards

- Cups, trophies and shields will be presented to the participant with the highest mark in the stated categories, provided the mark is 85 or higher.
- **E. C. Irving Musical Theatre Cup and Festival Award**  
is presented to an outstanding Junior performer who demonstrates exceptional performance ability in a solo class.
- **Caldwell-Roach Shield and Festival Award**  
is presented to an outstanding Intermediate performer who demonstrates exceptional performance ability in a solo class
- **Rob Bruce Cup and Festival Award**  
is presented to an outstanding Senior performer who demonstrates exceptional performance ability in a solo class
- **Adjudicator's Choice Awards and Provincial Recommendations**  
(see above)

#### Major Awards in Piano and Voice Solo Performances

- **Novice**  
In order to receive an award a performer must have competed in a minimum of two separate classes and the average of the top two marks must be 80 or greater
- **Junior**  
In order to receive an award a performer must have competed in a minimum of three separate classes and the average of the top three marks must be 85 or greater

- **Intermediate/Senior**  
In order to receive an award a performer must have competed in a minimum of three separate classes and the average of the top three marks must be 85 or greater
- **Open**  
In order to receive an award a performer must have competed in a minimum of three separate classes and the average of the top three marks must be 85 or greater
- **The Leslie Lake Searle Joy of Performance Award**  
is given to a performer in junior or senior high school who shows a passion for music performance. The performer must also give strong musical and artistic performances in both classical (voice or instrumental) and musical theatre (this includes Song And Dance). The performer must be supportive of his/her peers on and off stage.
- **The John E. Clarke and Annie L. Clarke Memorial Award** is presented to
  1. A male singer with changed voice, age 21 and under, who meets the qualifications for "major awards"
  2. A choir of unchanged male voices, or, in the absence of a choir entry, a small group of unchanged male voices

## OFFICIAL REGULATIONS and SYLLABUS

PRESENTED BY

THE FEDERATION OF MUSIC FESTIVALS OF NOVA SCOTIA

FOR THE

2008 NOVA SCOTIA PROVINCIAL MUSIC FESTIVAL

### I. CONTESTANT QUALIFICATION - JUNIOR and SENIOR

1. It is the responsibility of each contestant to read and comply with the rules and regulations governing the Provincial Music Festival, including the Concept and Dress Code as set out in competition guidelines. If clarification or assistance is needed, contestants should contact the Provincial Administrator/Registrar.
2. The Provincial Music Festival competition shall be open to live performance non-professional musicians residing or studying in Nova Scotia who perform at festivals affiliated through the Federation of Music Festivals of Nova Scotia.
3. A non-professional shall be defined as a person whose principal means of livelihood is not obtained from the performance of music in the particular category in which he or she is competing. This stipulation does not, however, preclude such a person having occasionally received remuneration for musical services rendered, even in the area in which he or she is competing.
4. Contestants in Senior Classes 1 through 7 and 13 shall not be over the age of 28 on December 31 prior to the Provincial Festival. Local Festivals must obtain proof of age. Contestants in Junior Classes 101 through 107 & 113 shall not be over age 18 as of December 31 prior to the Provincial Festival.
5. A written recommendation from the adjudicator is necessary before any contestant may advance from the Local Festival to the Provincial Level. The recommendation from the Local Level must be signed by the contestant, signifying knowledge of and agreement with the General Regulations. Deadlines for entries to the Provincial Music Festival should be received by the Registrar one month from the conclusion of the local festival or by May 16 whichever comes first.
6. Solo contestants may enter the Nova Scotia Provincial Music Festival classes in local festivals only if they reside or study in Nova Scotia, and may be recommended to the Provincial Level by only one festival in Nova Scotia.
7. The majority (51%) of members in a chamber group must study or reside in Nova Scotia.
8. No marks shall be given but the winner in each class at the Provincial Level shall be named.
9. Should a regular member of a Chamber Group (for valid reasons) be unable to proceed to the Provincial Music Festival, **one** substitution will be permitted.
10. Arrangements will be made for contestants by the Host Festival to practice at the Provincial Music Festival.
11. Senior: A first-place winner in Classes 1 through 7 at the Provincial Music Festival who has placed first at the National Festival shall not be eligible to compete in the same class at succeeding Provincial Music Festivals in the following 3 years.
12. There shall be no non-sanctioned recording or photographing of contestants during performances.
13. The President of the Federation of Music Festivals of Nova Scotia shall be the final authority in all matters pertaining to the Provincial Festival.

### II. REPERTOIRE

1. A high standard of music selection is expected at each level, both Local Festival and Provincial Festival.  
SENIOR: Selections must be of advanced difficulty and should include at least one large scale work, as defined in Va, #1.

JUNIOR: Juniors must be performing at least Grade 8 (Grade 7 for voice) repertoire as recognized by any Canadian Conservatory of Music (Grade 4 for Chamber Group as defined by Music Company literature).

2. All copyrights **must** be observed. Photocopies or manual copies of copyright music will not be accepted, unless written permission has been obtained from the publisher. Contestants must provide original scores of music, containing **solo and accompaniment** in the proper key, for the adjudicator. **The accompanist** must perform from another **original** score, and members of chamber groups must perform from **original parts**. Failure to do so automatically disqualifies the contestant. As an aid to the adjudicator, contestants **must number** the first bar of each line in their scores.
3. Memory work is mandatory in Senior Classes 1 through 6 and 16, and Junior Class 101. It is strongly recommended that contestants perform from memory in Junior Classes 102 through 106 and 116.
4. Contestants in solo classes who have previously competed at the Provincial Level shall not repeat repertoire previously used in competition. In the Chamber Group class, if more than one member returns, no repetition of music will be allowed.
5. Contestants shall be responsible for providing their own accompanists and covering the accompanists' expenses. Accompaniment is restricted to one (1) piano in Senior Classes 1 through 6 (4 excluded) as well as 13, and in Junior Classes 101 through 106 (104 excluded) as well as 113. The accompanist's name **must** be submitted with registration.

## III. CONTESTANT CONDUCT

### for both Junior and Senior competitors in the PROVINCIAL MUSIC FESTIVAL

This code has been developed to provide the best conditions for competitors in the Provincial Music Festival. Competitors should always remember they are guests of the Provincial Music Festival.

1. After arriving at the Festival, contestants are to remain for the duration of the Festival and take part in all functions such as performance workshops, classes, adjudications and the Grand Awards Concert.
2. Performance adjudications will be given following the conclusion of the Provincial class. Workshops will be scheduled on either of the two festival days. Unless there are extenuating circumstances, it is expected that all contestants will attend these workshops prepared to perform.
3. Contestants are prohibited from being in contact with the adjudicators until competitions are completed.
4. All contestants are expected to attend the Grand Awards Concert. The winners are required to perform. Formal attire is required for all performers.
5. Contestants must be considerate of others by observing practice and rehearsal times.
6. Practice rooms will be available for all contestants and accompanists.
7. Contestants are encouraged to attend as many of the competitions as possible.
8. No alcoholic beverages or illegal substances are allowed on the Festival site. Any infringement of this rule will lead to disqualification.
9. The Federation of Music Festivals of Nova Scotia is not responsible for lost or damaged musical instruments.

## IV. GUIDELINES FOR LOCAL FESTIVALS

1. Each of the registered Music Festivals in Nova Scotia is eligible to send one (1) entry to each of the 8 Senior classes and each of the 8 Junior classes in the Provincial Festival, providing each has been recommended by the respective adjudicator. Alternates may be recommended at the discretion of the adjudicator should a satisfactory standard be obtained.
2. Adjudicator recommendation forms with fees from the Local Festivals must be received by the Provincial Festival Registrar one month from the **conclusion of the local festival or by May 16**, whichever comes first.
3. Secretaries of local Festivals will be advised regarding time and place of the provincial level of competition in their respective areas.

## Va. ADDED PERFORMANCE REGULATIONS - SENIOR

1. For the purpose of the Provincial Festival, Classes 2, 3, 5, 6, a Concerto or Concerted Work is defined as any composition **originally** written for solo instrument with orchestral accompaniment.
2. Own Choice selection is defined as "a single movement composition or one or more movements of a multi-movement composition". Song cycles are an example of a multi-movement work.
3. In Senior Class 1, contestants proceeding to the Provincial Level of competition **must** include selection(s) on which they were recommended by the adjudicator at the local level. The recommended selections must include an operatic aria or a sacred aria from the standard repertoire.
4. In Senior Classes 2, 3, 5, 6, contestants proceeding to the Provincial Level of competition must perform at least two (2) consecutive movements of the selection on which they were recommended by the adjudicator at the local level.
5. Contestants are advised to reflect a **variety of styles and periods** in their choice of repertoire.
6. Contestants are encouraged to use **Canadian compositions** in their performances.

## CLASS 1 - VOCAL SOLO (SENIOR), Any Voice

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior Opera, with recitative where applicable, Senior Sacred Aria (aria from a major sacred work), with recitative where applicable, or Provincial Class, as provided for in the Local Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 40 minutes
- 2 or more languages to be used
- **three selections** consisting of:
  1. One selection from an Opera, with recitative where applicable, original key, language optional
  2. One Aria from a major sacred work, with recitative where applicable, original key, language optional
  3. One Own Choice selection

## CLASS 2 - PIANOFORTE SOLO (SENIOR)

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior Sonata, Concerto, Concerted Work or Provincial Class, as provided for in the Local Festival Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 40 minutes
- **two selections** consisting of:
  1. **At least two consecutive movements** of a Senior Sonata or Concerto, or a complete Concerted Work
  2. One Own Choice selection (but **not** another movement from the above)

## CLASS 3 - STRING SOLO (SENIOR)

Contestants are requested to state which instrument they will play.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior Concerto, Concerted Work or Provincial Class, as provided for in the Local Festival Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 40 minutes
- **two selections** consisting of:
  1. **At least two consecutive movements** of a Senior Concerto, or a complete Concerted Work
  2. One Own Choice selection (but **not** another movement of the above)

## CLASS 4 - CLASSICAL GUITAR (SENIOR)

Only solo, unaccompanied work is permitted.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior, advanced work or Provincial Class, as provided for in the Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit to be determined by the provincial association
- only solo, unaccompanied works are permitted
- **two selections** consisting of:
  1. One Own Choice selection of a senior or advanced work that may be a multi-movement work.
  2. One Own Choice selection, but **not** another movement of the above work.

## CLASS 5 - WOODWIND SOLO (SENIOR)

Contestants are requested to state which instrument they will play.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior Concerto, Concerted Work or Provincial Class, as for in the Local Festival Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 40 minutes
- **two selections** consisting of:
  1. **At least two consecutive movements** of a Senior Concerto, or a complete Concerted Work
  2. One Own Choice selection (but **not** another movement of the above) provided

## CLASS 6 - BRASS SOLO (SENIOR)

Contestants are requested to state which instrument they will play.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior Concerto, Concerted Work or Provincial Class, as for in the Local Festival Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 40 minutes
- **two selections** consisting of:
  1. **At least two consecutive movements** of a Senior Concerto, or a complete Concerted Work
  2. One Own Choice selection (but **not** another movement of the above) provided

## CLASS 7 - CHAMBER GROUP (SENIOR)

Contestants are requested to state their voice category or instrument. A combination of any recognized orchestral instruments including harp, guitar, recorder and/or percussion with or without piano and/or one voice, with a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 6 performers, one performer to a part. When piano is included, the piano part must be original and not an orchestral reduction. Amplification may be used only as indicated in the original score (not electronic instruments, only amplification) A percussion ensemble must meet chamber group definition assuming they play required repertoire and must understand that all equipment, except piano, is the responsibility of the performer.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from a Senior or Provincial Class, as provided for in the Local Festival Syllabus. No conductor

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 40 minutes including set-up, tuning, pauses and striking (removal of equipment)
- **two selections** consisting of:
  1. **At least two consecutive movements** of own choice selection performed at Local level
  2. One Own Choice selection (but **not** another movement of the above)

## CLASS 16 - SENIOR MUSICAL THEATRE

Repertoire for this class is restricted to music from stage productions only. Music from movies or television productions is not permitted and will result in disqualification. Interpretation must be of the character originally written by the dramatist.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from Musical Theatre Classes or Provincial Musical Theatre Class in the Local Festival Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- ACCOMPANIMENT- For the sake of logistics, accompaniment shall be restricted to one piano, which will be provided at the venue.
- PROPS - Props must be set up on the stage within three minutes. Abuse of this time limit will result in disqualification. On-stage props should be inanimate. The piano must be respected as an instrument and not used as a prop; similarly, the pianist is an accompanist and not a stage character.
- TIME LIMIT - Actual performance time of the piece should not exceed seven minutes.

## Vb. ADDED PERFORMANCE REGULATIONS-JUNIORS

1. Each contestant will perform live two contrasting Own Choice selections, which will be the qualifying selections performed at the local Music Festival and recommended by the Adjudicator.
2. The maximum time is 20 minutes, except vocal, which is 15 minutes.

### CLASS 101 - JUNIOR VOCAL SOLO, Any voice

#### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 7 conservatory level or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

#### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 15 minutes
- recommended but not compulsory that one foreign language be used
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music.

### CLASS 102 - JUNIOR PIANO SOLO

#### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 8 conservatory level or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

#### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 20 minutes
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music.

### CLASS 103 - JUNIOR STRING SOLO

Contestants are requested to state which instrument they play.

#### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 8 conservatory level or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

#### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 20 minutes
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music.

### CLASS 104 - JUNIOR CLASSICAL GUITAR

Only a solo, unaccompanied work is permitted.

#### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 8 conservatory level or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

#### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 20 minutes
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music

## CLASS 105 - JUNIOR WOODWIND SOLO

Contestants are requested to state which instrument they play.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 8 conservatory level or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 20 minutes
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music.

## CLASS 106 - JUNIOR BRASS SOLO

Contestants are requested to state which instrument they play.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 8 conservatory level or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 20 minutes
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music.

## CLASS 107 - JUNIOR CHAMBER GROUP

Contestants are requested to state their voice category or which instruments they play. A combination of any recognized orchestral instruments including harp, guitar, recorder and/or percussion with or without piano and/or one voice, with a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 6 performers, one performer to a part. When piano is included, the piano part must be original and not an orchestral reduction. **No conductor.**

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from classes of a minimum grade 4 ensemble literature or Provincial Class in the Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- maximum time limit of 20 minutes
- two contrasting selections of a high standard of music

## CLASS 116 - JUNIOR MUSICAL THEATRE

Repertoire for this class may be any music from stage productions or movie musicals.

### Local Festival

- Contestants must be recommended from Musical Theatre Classes or Provincial Musical Theatre Class in the Syllabus.

### Provincial Festival

- ACCOMPANIMENT - For the sake of logistics, accompaniment shall be kept to one piano, which will be provided at the venue.
- PROPS - Props must be set up on the stage within three minutes. Abuse of this time limit will result in disqualification. On-stage props should be inanimate. The piano and pianist are not to be used as props.

- TIME LIMIT - Actual performance time of the piece should not exceed seven minutes.

## VI. CHORAL REGULATIONS

*Note: Choirs submitting CDs or DVDs to the Provincial Level of competition must perform the same selections on which they were recommended by the adjudicator at the local level.*

1. Participation is limited to amateur Nova Scotia choirs, performing in the appropriate class(es) at affiliated festivals.
2. A festival official must supervise and witness the recording of the performance of choirs recommended for Provincial competition. Recording guidelines are available from your Provincial Festival Office.
3. If a CD/DVD is submitted for adjudication at the Provincial Festival, the same CD/DVD must be submitted to the National Festival. Conversely, a live performance at the Provincial level shall be recorded and that CD/DVD submitted to the National level.
4. The performance should be recorded on a CD or audio DVD. No acoustic or electronic compensation, filtering, or other enhancement is to be used while recording.
5. CDs/DVDs and music should contain no reference to the name of the choir, its conductor or the festival from which the tape has been sent.
6. It is preferable to have the recording done during the actual performance but should this not be feasible, it must be done within three weeks with the same choir, conductor, accompanist, and accompaniment as in the original performance. CDs/DVDs should be its first take.
7. A complete original music score for each selection, in the proper key, is required for the adjudicators. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification. As an aid to the adjudicators, the first bar of each line in the score must be numbered.
8. All copyrights regarding music must be observed. Manual copies or photocopies of copyright music will not be accepted.

The competition will be conducted at two progressive levels:

### **Local Festival**

Adjudicators at the local festival may choose, in each of the ten Choral categories, one choir which is felt to be of Provincial standard. The written recommendation along with the CDs/DVDs of the performance and original music shall be sent to the Provincial Registrar.

### **Provincial Festival**

Adjudicators at the provincial festival may choose, in each category submitted, one choir which is felt to be of National standard. The written recommendation along with the CDs/DVDs of the performance and original music shall be sent to the Executive Director of the Federation of Canadian Music Festivals by registered mail.

## CHORAL CLASSES

**CLASS 8 – HONOURABLE BARBARA A. HAGERMAN** - for the best performance by a community choral group of 13 or more singers, the majority of whom are 19 years and over. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts. Only one of the selections may be a folk song. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 9 - CITY OF LINCOLN** - for the best performance by a community choral group of 13 or more male singers. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 10 - GEORGE S. MATHIESON** - for the best performance by a community choral group of 13 or more singers, aged 19 years and under as of December 31 prior to the National Festival. Five percent (5%) of the choir membership may exceed the specified age limit by no more than two (2) years. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 11 – PAUL J. BOURRET** - for the best performance by a choral group from a single school, of 13 or more singers aged 19 and under. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 12 - RICHARD W. COOKE** - for the best performance by a community ensemble of 8 to 12 singers, with no age limitations. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts and one of which must be a madrigal. Brief solo passages are allowed. Contemporary madrigals will be accepted.

**CLASS 13 - DR & MRS. J.F.K. ENGLISH** - for the best performance by a community choral group of 13 or more singers, aged 16 years and under as of December 31 prior to the National Festival. Five percent (5%) of the choir membership may exceed the specified age limit by no more than two (2) years. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 14 – DAVID OUCHTERLONY** - for the best performance by a choral group from a single school, of 13 or more singers aged 16 and under as of December 31 prior to the National Festival. Five percent (5%) of the choir membership may exceed the specified age limit by no more than two (2) years. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in two or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 15 - MARGARET WHARTON MEMORIAL** - for the best performance by a community choral group, of 13 or more singers aged 12 years and under as of December 31 prior to the National Festival. Five percent (5%) of the choir membership may exceed the specified age limit by no more than two (2) years. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in two or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 16 - THE SISTER FLORINE DESPRES PLAQUE** for the best performance by a choral group from a single school, of 13 or more singers aged 12 years and under as of Dec. 31 prior to the National Festival. Five (5%) percent of the choir membership may exceed the specified age limit by no more than two (2) years. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in two or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

**CLASS 17 - BARBARA CLARK PLAQUE AND AWARD** for the best performance by a choral group of 13 or more singers, aged 25 years and under as of Dec. 31 prior to the National Festival. Five (5%) percent of the choir membership may exceed the specified age limit by no more than two (2) years. Competition is based on the total performance of two contrasting selections, one of which must be sung in three or more parts. Only one of the two selections may be a folksong. Brief solo passages are allowed.

## BAND & INSTRUMENTAL CLASSES

*All individual instrument and band classes are "Own Choice". If Band Directors wish to meet and agree on selected pieces for their classes, they are encouraged to do so.*

*In all band classes, evaluation will be based on a Gold, Silver and Bronze standard.*

The Truro Music Festival will base its school band classes (6411-6415) on the Canadian Band Association's National Voluntary Curriculum and Standards for Instrumental Music (Band). Conductors/Directors are expected to enter a class which is most suitable to their band's performance level. The choice of material determines the level at which a band will enter. Where more than one piece is required for a class, both are expected to be at the same level.

Music for each class is based on the following assumed criteria and should be used as a guide when making the class selection.

**B-100** (2 yrs. study) Basic rhythms, restricted ranges, underdeveloped technique, homophonic texture, uniformity of rhythms, ample doubling, much full- and half-tutti scoring.

**B-200** (3 yrs. study) Intermediate rhythms, some syncopation, duplet and triplet rhythms, expanded ranges, reasonably fluent technique, changing meters (4-3-2, etc.), some cross-cuing.

**B-300** Challenging rhythms, free use of syncopation, free use of section and solo scoring, independence of parts, more diverse instrumentation, more extended ranges and technique.

**B-400** Challenging rhythms, free use of syncopation, changing meters, asymmetrical meters, extended ranges for all instruments, very fluent technique, free use of solo writing, diverse instrumentation - especially woodwinds and percussion.

**B-500/600** Very challenging rhythms (including polyrhythms), changing meters, asymmetrical rhythms, non-metrical notation, extreme ranges for all instruments, extremely fluent technique, free use of solo writing, diverse instrumentation - especially woodwinds and percussion.

In addition to the general rules that apply to all entries, the following will apply:

1. Bands will be allotted approximately one hour each, which will allow time for set-up, warm-up and tuning, the performance selections, and the adjudication. The balance of the time (approximately one-half hour) will be dedicated to a workshop with the adjudicator. Other bands are encouraged to attend as many of these sessions as they are able, as we expect every workshop will be of value to all entrants. **Please note:** the Festival may limit the number of entries rather than sacrifice the time allotment for the performances, adjudications and the workshops.

2. A band may enter at one level only (i.e. the same band/ensemble may NOT enter one class at the 100 level and one class at the 200 level). However, a selection at the Open (B-500/B-600) level may be added to an entry at any level.

3. The Festival will supply up to 60 chairs and stands, bass drum and stand, and three tympani. Participants are expected to supply their own percussion equipment beyond these items. Entrants must attach a diagram of the band seating plan to the application form, indicating the count and placement of chairs and stands - we will use this plan to assist with set-up.
